

BUILDINGS/FIRE/POLICE
COMMITTEE'S
MINUTES

The Building committee met on Monday, Nov 23 at 5:45 PM. Present were members JP Fagnant, and Don Chioffi. Joe Dicton also sat in on the meeting. The committee reviewed all submissions of contractors for the Renovations of the Town Hall for compliance with the bid specs advertised. All bids were in compliance and the committee will recommend to the full board that the town award the bid to the low bidder, The Smalley Corporation at \$44,000, that amount to be allocated from the Capital Construction line item in this year's budget. Meeting adjourned at 6 PM.

The Fire Committee met at 6 PM with Joe Dicton, Don Chioffi and Chief Frank Cioffi in attendance. A very productive Budget discussion with the Chief on each and every line item was conducted and the committee came to a recommended budget to be presented by the Chief to the full board. This year's increase was kept to a very reasonable small percentage amount. The meeting was adjourned at 7 PM.

The Police committee met at 7 PM with Joe Dicton, Don Chioffi, Chief Dumas, and Captain Washburn present. After considerable discussion concerning just how the Resource Officer's funding and application of budgeted wage amounts from this year, and also discussion of a long range program for capital expenditures, the committee came to a basic agreement on the budget submission for this March. The committee will await board discussion and agreement on any wage and salary adjustments for the coming year before presenting a final Police Budget. The goal is to keep the budget in the range of 1 to 2 % increase. The meeting adjourned at 8:30 PM.
