5 Year Plan

2017 = Set up for Town vote on a Capital improvement fund for the police department.

2018 = New cruiser purchase (1).

Another survey, more in depth to see what the town's needs are to carry us through the next 5 to 10 years.

Depending on the results of the survey, possibly the hiring of another full time fully certified officer for the road, to increase coverage during the busy times in the town and increase coverage on weekends. This could also in cooperate on call times as well during the times deemed necessary.

A full time Detective to stay assigned at CFAC into the future as this work affects all aspects of our communities not only Rutland Town but Rutland County and beyond. The State of Vermont has been funding these positions for smaller departments now for several years.

Full time Records keeper as the needs for collecting data and making decisions based on stats are driving police work for the future. FACEBOOK page for the Department which could be managed with the Records keeper and assigned Administrator.

A Facility to house the Rutland Town Police Department in a separate spot but possibly when improvements are made to the Rutland Town McKinley Fire Station. The two department heads have already started talking about a joint Fire and Police Station. The Station design should take into consideration the needs of the town for the next 20 years or more. Special needs will be for safe secure storage of criminal records and cases generated within the Town.
