

RUTLAND TOWN SELECT BOARD
INTERMUNICIPAL COMMITTEE MEETING

3/13/2018

The Intermunicipal Committee of the Rutland Town Select Board met at 10AM in Tuesday, March 13th at the Rutland Town Offices. Present were Board members Josh Terenzini and Joe Denardo as well as Road Commissioner Byron Hathaway, Town Administrative Assistant Bill Sweet, Rutland City Mayor David Allaire, Rutland City Public Works Commissioner Jeff Wenneberg and Rutland City Engineer Jim Rotondo.

Campbell Road

- The group discussed the plans to upgrade and repave an approximately ½ mile section of Campbell Road. Rutland City is currently working on plans to upgrade the existing water main from Park St, connecting to Dorr Drive and continuing up to Campbell Road.
- This plan includes approximately ½ mile of reclaiming the existing pavement and repaving.
- There is water main work planned next to approximately 1500' of the roadway
- Proposal of the town paying for the cost of the repaving, at our lower cost, and Rutland City reimbursing the town for this cost. The proposal will be brought to the full Rutland Town Select Board.

There being no further business to discuss the meeting was adjourned at 11AM.
