RUTLAND TOWN SELECT BOARD
INTERMUNICIPAL COMMITTEE MEETING
MAY 8TH, 2018

The Intermunicipal Committee of the Rutland Town Select Board met at 1115 AM, Tuesday My 8th at the Rutland City Hall. Present were Board members Josh Terenzini and Joe Denardo as well as Town Road Commissioner Byron Hathaway, Town Administrative Assistant to the Select Board Bill Sweet, Rutland City Mayor Dave Allaire, Rutland City Public Works Commissioner Jeff Wenneberg and Rutland City Engineer Jim Rotondo.

Campbell Road

- The group discussed the proposed plan to repave the section of Campbell Road in the city.
- Discussed the distribution of cost to repave the road from the meeting on March 13th.
- An MOU was received from Rutland City which obligated Rutland Town to ½ of the final cost after funds from the water project were deducted from the total.
- The original intention of the offer from Rutland Town was to bid the project using our price, complete the project and bill the city for the full cost of repaving.
- The estimated cost of the paving project is \$86098 using the Town bid price
- The cost using the city bid price is approximately \$114,000.
- The gap in the city budget to complete the project is approximately \$16,000.
- After further discussion the Town Intermunicipal Committee will report back to the full Rutland Town Select Board on May 29th.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned at 12:00 PM.
