

RUTLAND TOWN SELECT BOARD

FIRE COMMITTEE MEETING

MAY 29TH, 2018

The Fire Committee of the Rutland Town Select Board met at 5 PM, Tuesday May 29th at the Rutland Town Hall. Present were board members Josh Terenzini, JP Faignant. Also present was Board Administrative Assistant Bill Sweet, Fire Chief Frank Cioffi, Asst Fire Chief Chris Clark and Asst Fire Chief Mike Carlson.

1. The committee discussed the bids received for replacing the Rutland Town FD airpacks.
 - A. Each of the bids received were reviewed to determine if they met the bid specs
 - B. Discussion of the difference in each of the warranty periods
 - C. The highest bid received was \$23233.53 below the anticipated costs
 - D. The committee will recommend to the full board to accept the bid for the MSA airpacks from Reynolds and Son.
2. Mr. Cioffi informed the committee of an issue recently found behind the Center Rutland Fire Station. The surface at the top of the retaining wall is eroding. Some crushed stone will be used to fill in the holes in an attempt to stop the erosion.
3. Discussion of the sensors for the ventilation system at the Center Rutland Fire Station
 - A. The committee will recommend to the full board to purchase replacement sensors
4. Mr. Cioffi updated the committee on the progress of installing flower beds in front of the Center Rutland Fire Station.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned at 5:28 PM.
