- Discussion of CR7 (add trees and other traffic calming elements)
- Discussion of CR8 (bus stops and shelters)
- Discussion of BR 4 (expand industrial use on Carris Reels property)
- Discussion of BR 5, referred recommendation to CR4
- Discussion of BR 7, (bus stops and shelters) BR {Business Route} section defined as Route 3 to West Rutland Jug handle. Same recommendation as CR study will be given

- Discussion of BR8 (trees and other traffic calming elements) Same recommendation as CR study will be given
- Discussion of BR9 (create a shared use path along the Clarendon river)
